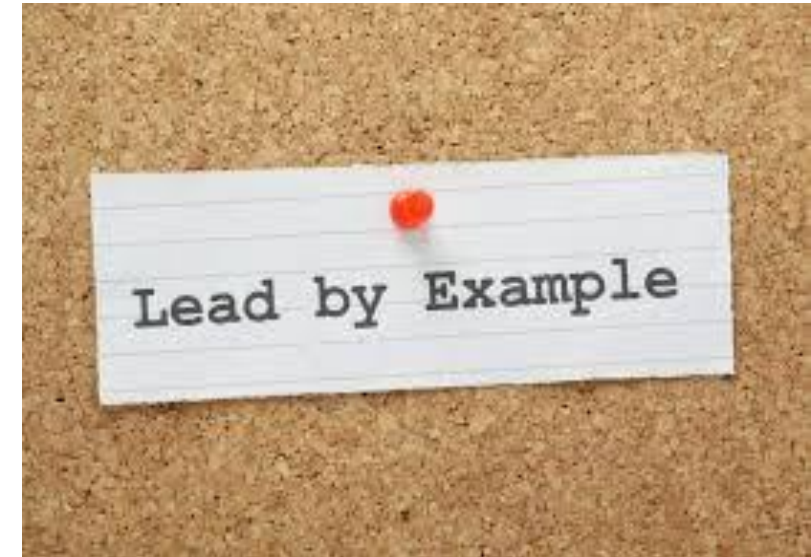

# Tuck Shop

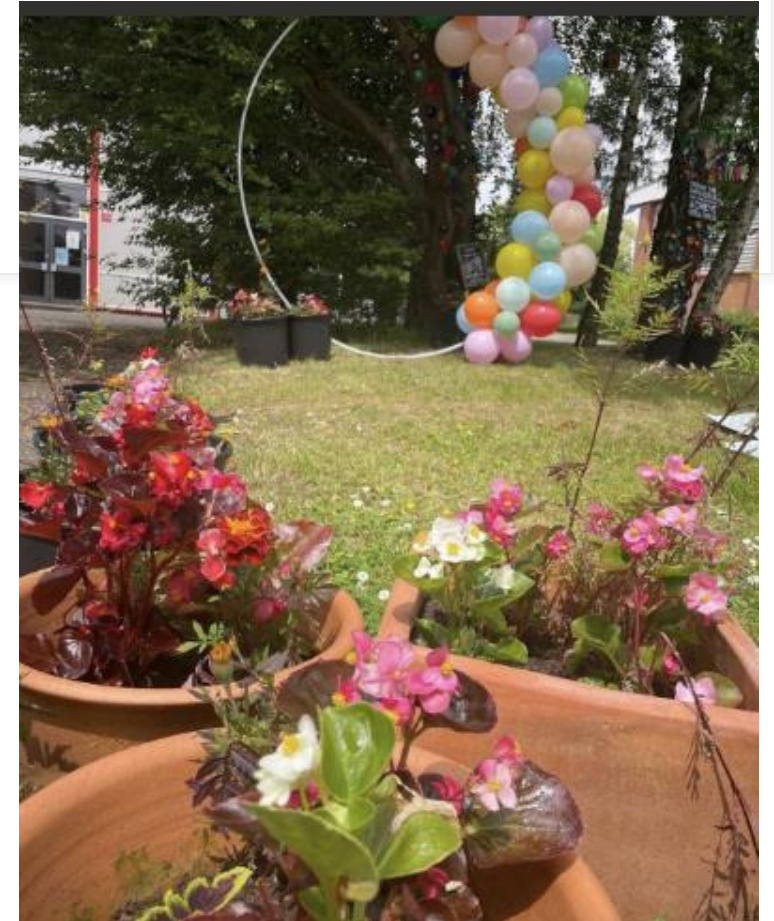


- Available before am tutor / break and lunch time only
